

Covid-19 Policy

Things may still be a little different during these turbulent times and our number one priority is the health and safety of all of our Friends, guests, community and staff.

With the latest guidelines set out by the Government we are asking all of our friends and guests to be patient and bare with us as we adjust our business moving forward.

We are kindly asking you all to read further on how we are now operating and our asks from you.

- Reserve - Following guidelines we are asking all our guests to reserve tables in advance, you can do this online or by giving us a call on 0151 428 1623.
- Table service - We will be operating offering table service only policy to all of our guests.
- 2 hours per booking - Due to demand all bookings will be allocated 2 hours.
- Wash hands regularly - It's important to us to ensure health and safety to all of our guests and staff so we are asking you to wash your hands regularly, we will also be providing hand sanitiser to help fight the transmission of COVID-19.
- Indoor gatherings - Should only be occurring in groups of up to 2 households (including support bubbles). With our reduced

capacity, we are not having bookings over 6 guests per table. Guests are reminded that children must be supervised at all times.

- Toilets - Regular inspections and cleaning will be in operation.
- Social Distancing - All tables will be correctly distanced from one another.
- Card payments - We encourage contactless or chip and pin payments.

Rub soap all over your palms, the backs of your hands, and in between your fingers
